Post-Dental Home Care

- Your pet has had an anaesthetic today and as a result may feel nauseated. Only if your pet is interested, please give them half their normal evening meal.
- If your pet has had extractions you can feed a soft food for the first few days postoperatively. Soaking dry food thoroughly with warm water or canned food are some options.
- Any sutures in the mouth are dissolvable.
- If prescribed, please start any take home medication tomorrow. Antibiotics are for the prevention and treatment of infection. Please contact us for assistance if you have any difficulty medicating your pet.
- We appreciate the confidence you show in us by leaving your pet in our care. We realize your pet was probably cleaned and groomed upon admittance. Soiling of the hair coat may occur during dental procedures or recovery from anaesthesia. We have made every effort to ensure your pet's appearance is acceptable when discharged. If we have failed, PLEASE let us know.
